CHINA'S FIRST ENERGY SERVICE COMPANY ESTABLISHED IN TEDA

Recently SDI (Tianjin) Energy Service Co., Ltd., founded by Scientific Drilling International (SDI) of America, was registered in TEDA. It is the first energy service company of SDI in China.

With 220 million dollars and headquartered in Huston, Texas of the US, SDI is the fourth largest directional well drilling company in the western hemisphere. SDI is advanced in directional drilling and survey of oil-gas wells, equipment R&D, services and equipment for coalbed drilling and geothermal logging, and has the highest customer satisfaction index in directional drilling.

SDI (Tianjin) Energy Service Company mainly provides services to PetroChina and coalbed gas survey companies. It aims at offering engineering and technical services for the survey and exploration of crude oil, natural gas and coalbed gas, especially underground steering services for the exploration of crude oil and survey of coalbed gas. SIXTH INVESTMENT INCREASE OF VESTAS IN TEDA

Vestas Wind Technology (China) Co., Ltd. recently added another 21.6 million dollar investment and 8.64 million dollar registered capital. With the sixth investment increase since its establishment in TEDA, the total investment and registered capital of Vestas Wind Technology (China) Co., Ltd. have reached 384 million dollars and 133 million dollars respectively.

Vestas Wind Technology (China) Co., Ltd. is solely funded by Vestas of Denmark in China. Since its establishment in the West Zone of TEDA in 2005, the company has kept expanding. At present its plants of blades, nacelles, generators, controllers, and machining have been build up and put to use. MASTER KONG TIANJIN REINVESTS IN TEDA

Master Kong (Tianjin) Beverage Co., Ltd., a subsidiary of Tinghsin International recently reinvested in TEDA to catch up with its ever growing market demand.

This time, Master Kong (Tianjin) increased its total investment by 30 million dollars and registered capital by 10 million dollars. After the reinvestment, the company's total investment increased to 91 million dollars and its registered capital to 30.5 million dollars. The new investment will be spent on two new production lines. Once completed, the new lines will increase the company's capacity by 16 million boxes.

Established in March 2006, Master Kong (Tianjin) Co., Ltd. is a major beverage producer under Tinghsin International. The company has an initial investment of 36

RESULTS OF FIE SURVEY RELEASED



At the invitation of TEDA Investment Promotion Bureau and TEDA International Chamber of Commerce, Euro Asia Consulting Co., Ltd. (EAC), together with Squire, Sanders & Dempsey L.L.P., recently released their survey results about foreign-invested enterprises (FIEs) in China at TEDA Investment Service Center.

They also shared their thoughts with local FIEs on how to respond to the financial crisis and make the right survival strategy.

The survey done by EAC and SSD on FIEs in China mainly touched upon the following subjects: the impact of the crisis on their China business and operation model, whether the enterprises should amend their China strategy, what measures should be taken to improve their local performance, how to benefit from China's stimulus package, and how to find its role in the ever-growing China market. The survey was participated by more than 230 FIEs and its initial results indicate that it is

time for China to adopt a package plan targeted at business reshuffle as soon as possible..

IFCAID CLOSSES SUCCESSFULLY

Jointly hosted by TEDA Administrative Commission, China Automotive Technology and Research Center (CATARC), Society of Automotive Engineers of China (SAE China) and China Association of Automobile Manufacturers (CAAM), the three-day 2009 International Forum on Chinese Automotive Industry Development (IFCAID) was held from September 4th to 6th at the Renaissance Tianjin TEDA Hotel.

In response to the global financial crisis, policy and market insiders touched upon a series of hotspot topics such as industry reshuffle and revitalization, future development trends, energy conservation, conventional energy, and rural market through the plenary session, VIP roundtables and workshops. Among the Forum's 600-plus audience, approximately 30 are ministerial officials, 70 experts, 300 senior executives (VP level and above) from major domestic and international auto companies, and 100 journalists.

As one of the hosts, TEDA was actively involved in the preparatory work and offered extensive information about local industry environment and incentive policies for auto industry. During the Forum, TEDA officials had intensive discussions with state ministers, domestic and international whole car and parts manufacturers, and management of professional consultancy firms respectively on a wide range of subjects including the future of the global auto industry amid financial crisis, and cooperation possibilities in new energy vehicles, whole car export, auto financing, auto marketing, etc. On the registration day, TEDA arranged a local tour for delegates from over 20 whole car and parts manufacturers, research institutions, financial service agencies, and consultancy firms. Vice Chairman Ni Xiangyu was also invited to give a presentation about the local industry environment and policy system. These events were well received by delegates and many expressed strong interest in working with TEDA in the auto field.

So far, TEDA has gathered 114 auto companies including four whole car manufacturers (Tianjin FAW Toyota, Tianjin Xingma, Tianjin Qingyuan Electric Vehicles, and Great Wall Motor) and 110 part suppliers. In addition, it has approximately 100 auto sales and service companies. In 2008, local auto output volume hit 365,800. From January to July this year, the output value for local whole car manufacturers stood at 27.3 billion yuan and that of parts manufacturers 9.2 billion yuan. Despite of the economic downturn, auto industry, as one of the pillar industries, is flying against the wind with an admirable 17.63% contribution rate to the region's total industrial output value.
